Activities include but not limited to: beep baseball, goalball, kayaking, fishing, gardening, dancing, etc. The Rainbow Day Camp is a 4-day camp created specifically for students ages 5–18 with vision loss.

Adults are welcome to volunteer in shifts or all day and are encouraged to commit to multiple shifts/days to provide the best experience for the youth. Individuals that are college aged or have experience as a camp counselor or working with children and youth preferred. This is a great opportunity for OT, PT, special education students or those pursuing similar degrees. Bus transportation will be provided daily from two locations to the JCC Camp for those that will be at camp all day. Volunteers must complete a mandatory training at Vision Forward before camp (date TBD).
