

Supersense Fact Sheet

General

- Supersense works on both iOS and Android.
- Supersense will open in smart scanner mode by default. This means you can scan short text, documents, currency, barcodes, and objects without needing to press anything.
- All of Supersense's features can be accessed from the feature selection menu, except for Object explorer, scene description, and object finder, which can be found in the explore menu.

Document Reader

- Supersense's document reader automatically fixes lighting issues, and will give you simple directions to help you get the clearest image of the document. I get a maximum of 2 errors per page.
- Supersense's document reader automatically divides documents up by paragraph, so you can swipe down with one finger to copy that paragraph to your clipboard and share it however you wish. You can also share entire documents via text, email, export them as pdf, or save them to any cloud service you have access to on your iPhone.
- Our document reader also highlights contact information, so you can instantly access street addresses, phone numbers, and email addresses. Call them, save a contact, or get directions right from Supersense!

- Our document reader can also scan hand writing, and any written language.
- You can also scan longer documents with our multipage document reader available from the feature selection menu.

Barcode Reader

- Supersense's barcode reader will beep when it sees the edge of a barcode. Move the camera so that Supersense beeps faster. The faster the app beeps, the closer you are to the barcode.
- Once Supersense recognizes the barcode, it will display the product's name. Click on the more details button to get brand information, a product description, ingredients, and nutritional facts for whatever you have scanned.

Read History

- Any document, banknote, barcode, photo, pdf, or piece of text you scan is saved locally in Supersense's read history until you close the app.
- You can copy, delete, and share items from read history.
- Your read history is not deleted when you close Supersense, but the information is only stored on your device. We don't store any of your data to protect the privacy of our users.

Supersense Importer

- You can use Supersense to read the text in photos from your camera roll. It will also describe them.
- Supersense can also scan pdf documents up to 400 pages.

Explore Mode

- Use Supersense's object explorer to recognize the objects in your area. It can detect obstacles, and help with navigation. Our database currently recognizes people, doors, chairs, tables, staircases, a variety of animals, and over 600 other objects.
- Use our object finder to select a category of object you are looking for, and Supersense will vibrate in your hand when it sees it. This is useful for navigating public bathrooms and other unknown spaces, as well as finding help and traveling.
- Use our scene description feature to take pictures of the world around you, and get Supersense will describe them.
- This is particularly useful if you want to take pictures and share them on social media, with friends, etc.

Pricing

- The free version of Supersense only includes quick read, our importer, a magnifier, and access to your read history.
- Supersense costs \$4.99 per month, \$49.99 per year, or \$99.99 for lifetime access.
- This price includes all bug fixes and features added to Supersense for the applicable time period.
- We charge for Supersense to fund our research efforts and continue developing the features you ask for in a timely fashion.
- Pricing may vary by location.
